Vice President, Associate General Counsel

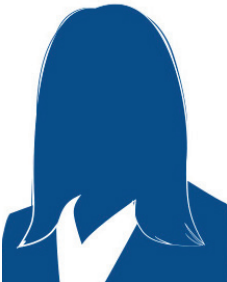
